About being an apostle


- Jesus chose them

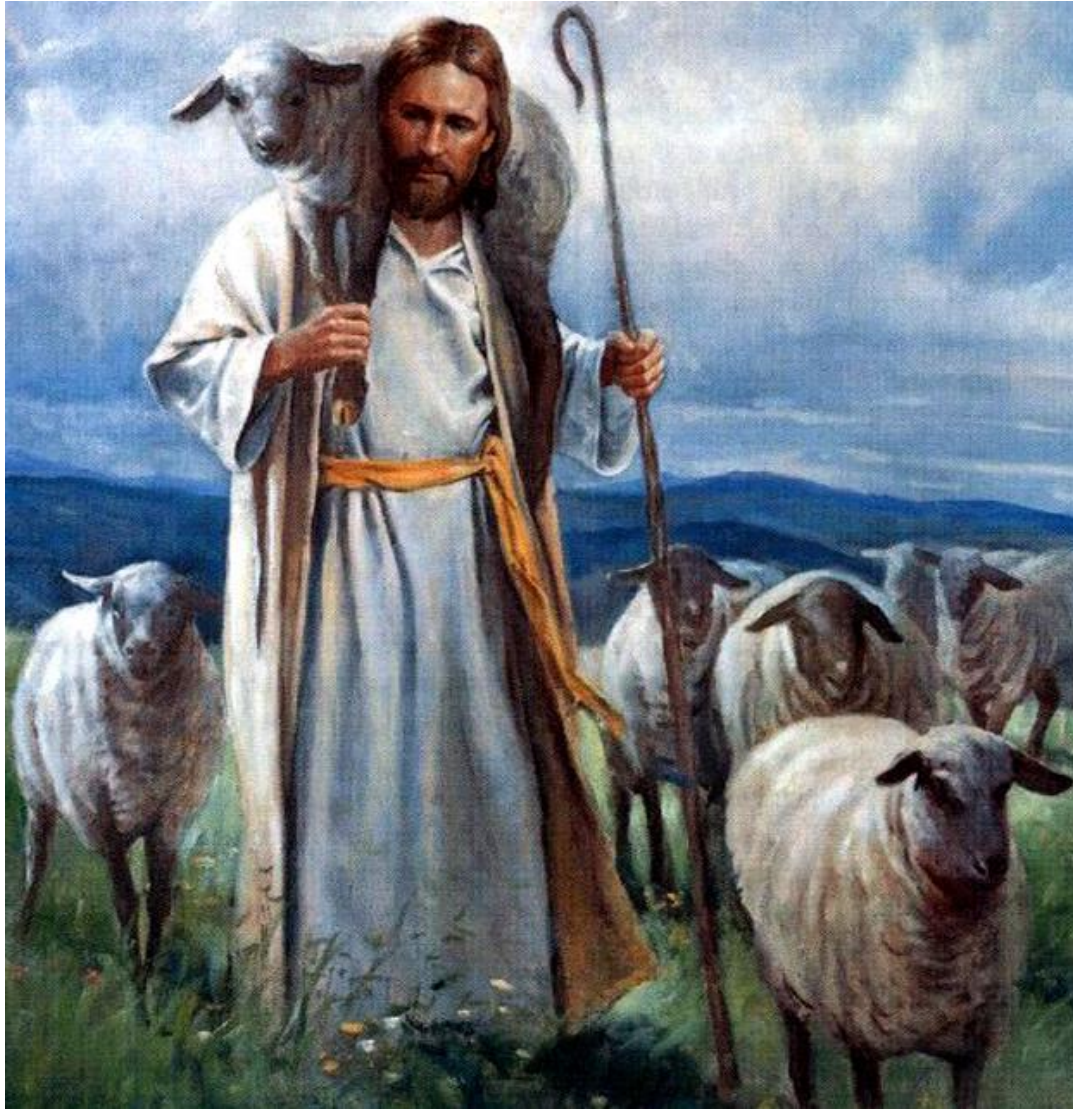


